

Certain clauses from the Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) and Defense Federal Acquisition Regulations Supplement (DFARS) apply to this Order (collectively, the “Flow-Down Clauses”). The Flow-Down Clauses listed below are incorporated into the Order by reference, with the same force and effect as if they were given in full text. The full text of each Flow-Down Clause may be accessed electronically at <https://www.acquisition.gov/content/regulations>.

Unless otherwise stated, the version of each Flow-Down Clause shall be the current version in effect at the time of the Order. In the event of a conflict between the current version of a Flow-Down Clause, and the version appearing in Draper’s Prime Contract version, the Prime Contract version shall control. If any Flow-Down Clause does not apply to this specific Order, such clause shall be deemed self-deleting.

Table 1 lists the Flow-Down Clauses applicable to Orders for Commercial Items purchased under a U.S. Government Prime Contract. If the Order is made under a U.S. Department of Defense Prime Contract, the Flow-Down Clauses in Table 2 shall also apply. In the event of a conflict between the Table 2 clauses, and the Table 1 clauses, the Table 2 clauses shall control.

As used in the Flow-Down Clauses:

- “Commercial Item” has the same meaning as defined in FAR 2.101.
- “Commercially Available Off-the-Shelf (COTS) Item” has the same meaning as defined in FAR 2.101.
- “Contract” means the Order.
- “Contracting Officer” means the U.S. Government Contracting Officer for Draper’s Prime Contract.
- “Contractor” or “Offeror” means Vendor.
- “Prime Contract” means the contract number listed on the face of the Order between Draper and the U.S. Government or between Draper and its higher-tier contractor who has a prime contract with the U.S. Government.
- “Service Contract” has the same meaning as defined in FAR 22.001.
- “Service Contract Labor Standards” means the Service Contract Labor Standards statute at 41 USC Chapter 67, and the regulations of the Secretary of Labor at 29 CFR Part 3. Generally, the Service Contracts Labor Standard applies to Service Contracts over \$2,500 to be performed in the United States through the use of Service Employees. 41 USC §6702 and 48 CFR § 22.1006 provide exceptions.
- “Service Employee” has the same meaning as defined in FAR 22.001.
- “Simplified Acquisition Threshold” has the same meaning as defined in FAR 2.101 (\$250,000 per GSA Class Deviation 2018-01, DARS Class Deviation 2018-00018, CAAC Class Deviation 2018-02)
- “Subcontract” means a contract placed by Vendor to a lower-tier vendor under this Order.
- “Subcontractor” means a lower-tier vendor to whom Vendor issues a Subcontract under this Order.

Unless otherwise specified below, Vendor shall provide any required reports or notices under a Flow-Down Clause to Draper.
